### Semen available this Spring

So we've known, based off the data from his calves in the US how great he is, but he has since been tested through Quantum Genetix for the Leptin gene traits and did the four trait test for Leptin, PMCH genotype, IGF2 genotype and the CRH genotype. Black Bardolier is a TT carrier for the Leptin genotype and also scored great on the other three tests. These genotypes indicate increased potential in areas of marbling, tenderness, ribeye and also cow longevity and milk production. Black Bardolier also tested great on the genotype related to stress response, docility and hot carcass weights.

This is very exciting as it confirms his true value as a sire on all fronts whether he be used purebred or on the commercial front. Black Bardolier ranks in Top 1% for YW, Top 2 % for \$Feedlot and high in several traits. For top phenotype and performance everywhere, he has been used all over the world. We have found his calves are born early, are exceptionally long and grow like crazy. We are very excited with the progeny we have on the ground to date.
